Authorizing The Mayor, Finance Director, And Commissioner of Recreation and Parks To Enter Into a Contract With CCBCC OPERATIONS LLC. To Provide Soft Drinks for City Sponsored Sporting Events Through December 31, 2025; And Declaring An Emergency

Summary and Background:

The Recreation and Parks Division received two quotes, and they feel that CCBCC OPERATIONS LLC is providing the lowest quote option for the City.

Oregon City Council has appropriated the necessary funds required for this product as part of the 2021 Municipal Budget in Fund 241.4100.52250.

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained By The Council Of The City Of Oregon, Ohio,
That:

Section 1. The Mayor, Finance Director, and Commissioner of Recreation and Parks are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with CCBCC OPERATIONS LLC, in accordance with Exhibit "A" attached and made a part hereof through December 31, 2025.

Section 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio and that the consideration, reading and adoption of this Ordinance complies with the provisions of Article III, Section 9, of the City Charter, as amended.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and signature by the Mayor. The reason for the emergency is to allow for the continued orderly distribution of the soft drinks at the City sporting events.
