Ordinance No. 071 – 2017

Accepting The Bid Of Peterson Construction Company, 18817 S.R. 501, Wapakoneta, Ohio 45895 For Furnishing Labor, Materials And Equipment For The Wastewater Treatment Plant Sludge Dewatering Improvements Project; Authorizing The Mayor, Director of Public Service And Finance Director To Enter Into A Contract With Said Contractor; And Declaring An Emergency

Summary And Background

Based on detailed design and bid results, a new biosolids or sludge dewatering facility consisting of two centrifuges along with disposing dry sludge at a landfill has been determined to be a very cost effective alternative, especially due to the rising costs of land applying liquid sludge to farmland.

The City has obtained a \$792,000 grant from the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) and a low interest loan through the Ohio EPA's Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) to finance the design and construction of the WWTP Sludge Dewatering Improvement Project.

Ordinance No. 1-2017 passed by Oregon City Council on January 9, 2017, authorized the Director of Public Service to take bids for projects such as the Wastewater Treatment Plant Sludge Dewatering Improvements Project.

Bids for construction were advertised in accordance with law and were received and opened on March 28, 2017.

The said project is included in the approved 2017 C.I.P. Municipal Budget in account 356.7704. 57736. **Now, Therefore,**

Be It Ordained By The Council Of The City Of Oregon, Ohio, That:

Section 1. The bid of Peterson Construction Company, 18817 S.R. 501, Wapakoneta, Ohio 45895, for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Sludge Dewatering Improvements Project in an amount not to exceed Three Million Ninety-Seven and 00/100 Dollars (\$3,000,097.00) be and the same is hereby accepted in accordance with prices as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. The Mayor, Director of Public Service and Finance Director are hereby authorized to enter into a contact with Peterson Construction Company, 18817 S.R. 501, Wapakoneta, Ohio 45895 in an amount not to exceed \$3,000,097.00 for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Sludge Dewatering Improvements Project.

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Section 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and that the consideration, reading and adoption of this Ordinance has been in accordance with Article III, Section 9 of the City Charter as amended.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect upon its passage and signature by the Mayor. The reason for the emergency lies in the fact that this Ordinance is necessary in order to let the construction in a timely manner.


