

NOTICE TO BIDDERS
Ordinance No. 1-2017

Sealed proposals marked for "City of Oregon, Ohio Pickle Road Storm Sewer Relief Ditch", will be received by the City of Oregon, Ohio, at the Office of the Director of Public Service at the Oregon Municipal Building, 5330 Seaman Road, Oregon, Ohio 43616, until 10:00 a.m., local time, on September 20, 2017, and then publicly opened and read aloud.

In general, the work for the Pickle Road Storm Sewer Relief Ditch – Part A, consists of the construction of 4,100 feet of 12-inch through 48-inch storm sewer including manholes, catch basins, the removal of 2,700 feet of 12-inch through 24-inch storm sewer, the abandonment of 330 feet of 18-inch storm sewer, and the construction of an 8.9 million gallon relief ditch.

The Work for the Pickle Road Storm Sewer Relief Ditch (Seaman Road/Brown Road Multi-Use Path, Phase 1) – Part B consists of construction of a 0.7 mile bikeway that will consist of a 10 foot wide asphalt, shared-use path. The scope of work consists of excavation, asphalt, concrete, concrete walk, aggregate base, pavement markings, drainage, and erosion-control items.

Copies of the Bidding Documents may be examined at the above office without charge. Deposits are non-refundable.

Bids must be submitted on the forms bound herein, must contain the names of every person or company interested therein, and shall be accompanied by either a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in the amount of 100% of the amount bid with satisfactory corporate surety, or by a certified check on a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the amount of the Bid, subject to conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.


Each bid must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested in therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity. The Owner intends and requires that this project be completed no later than 365 days following the issuance of the Notice to Proceed.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

The Contractor shall be required to pay not less than the prevailing wage rates established by State of Ohio.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 120 days after the actual date of the opening thereof. The Council of the City of Oregon, Ohio, reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids.
