

Ordinance No. 073 - 2018

Authorizing The Mayor, Finance Director And Director of Public Service To Enter Into A Contract With Midwest Compost, Inc., 7250 State Route 101, Clyde, Ohio 43410 For Removal Of Approximately 10,000 Tons Of Dry Solids For The Water Treatment Plant Spent Lime Disposal Service For A Period Of One (1) Year At A Cost Of \$36.60 Per Dry Ton Per Contract Specifications; And Declaring An Emergency

Summary And Background

Ordinance No. 1-2018 passed by Oregon City Council on January 8, 2018, authorized the Director of Public Service to receive bids for various items used in the various departments of the City.

Bids were advertised in accordance with law and were received and opened on June 21, 2018.

It has been determined by the Department of Public Service that the bid received is the lowest and bid to meet the needs of the City of Oregon. **Now, Therefore,**

Be It Ordained By The Council Of The City Of Oregon, Ohio, That:

Section 1. The Mayor, Finance Director and Director of Public Service are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Midwest Compost, Inc., 7250 State Route 101, Clyde, Ohio 43410 for removal of approximately 10,000 tons of dry solids for the Water Treatment Plant Lime Disposal Service for a period of one (1) year at a cost of \$36.60 per dry ton, per contract specifications, be and the same hereby accepted in accordance with unit prices as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and that the consideration, reading and adoption of this Ordinance has been in accordance with Article III, Section 9 of the City Charter as amended.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect upon its passage and signature by the Mayor. The reason for the emergency lies in the fact that this Ordinance is necessary to ensure the efficient operation of the Water Treatment Plant.


