

NOTICE TO BIDDERS
Ordinance No. 1-2018

Sealed proposals marked for “*Norden Road Sanitary Sewer (Seaman Road to Wolf Creek)*” will be received by the City of Oregon, Ohio, at the Office of the Director of Public Service at the Oregon Municipal Building, 5330 Seaman Road, Oregon, Ohio 43616, until 10:00 A.M., local time, on Thursday, November 29, 2018 and immediately thereafter publicly opened and read aloud.

In general, the work for **Norden Road Sanitary Sewer (Seaman Road to Wolf Creek)** consists of the installation of 952 linear feet of 8” sanitary sewer including sewer laterals. The work also includes driveway pavement replacement and project restoration.

All bids must be made on the proposal forms, which with the contract documents, including Specifications and Bid Forms are on file at the office of the Director of Public Service, 5330 Seaman Road, Oregon, Ohio 43616. A set may be obtained by depositing \$25.00, check only, with the Office of the Director of Public Service. Checks must be made payable to the City of Oregon. Deposits are non-refundable.


Each bid must be accompanied by either a bid bond in an amount of 10% of the bid amount with a surety satisfactory to the City or by certified check, cashier’s check, or letter of credit upon a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the bid amount in favor of the City of Oregon.

Bid bonds shall be made accompanied by Proof of Authority of the official or agent signing the bond. A Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond properly executed can be submitted in lieu of a bid bond or check.

Attention of bidders is called to all of the requirements contained in this bid packet, particularly to the prevailing wages, various insurance requirements, various equal opportunity provisions; and the requirements for a performance bond or a bid guaranty and contract bond for 100% of the contract price.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof. The Council of the City of Oregon, Ohio, reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids.
