

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed proposals marked for “**URBAN RUNOFF CAPTURE AND OTTER CREEK RESTORATION PROJECT**” will be received by the City of Oregon, Ohio, at the Office of the Director of Public Service at the Oregon Municipal Building, 5330 Seaman Road, Oregon, Ohio 43616, until 10:00 A.M., local time, on Thursday, July 11, 2019, and then opened and read aloud.

The scope of work includes the construction of a stormwater treatment system, storm sewer, parking area, and associated restoration in the Eastmoreland and Euclid Park subdivisions of the City of Oregon. Storm sewer construction on Eastvale Avenue will include an estimated 1,312 linear feet of 21” storm sewer and an estimated 563 linear feet of 18” storm sewer. Excavation and grading for the stormwater treatment system will include the creation of a 0.5 acre forebay and various wetland features by excavation and grading. A total basin volume of 124,273 cubic feet will be created. Landscaping includes the installation of wetland plugs, trees, shrubs, and various floodplain and upland seed mixes, as well as invasive species control.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in an amount of 10% of the bid amount in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Information To Bidders. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be satisfactory to the City and be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.

Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity. The City of Oregon intends and requires that this project be completed no later than June 1, 2020.

Attention of bidders is called to all of the requirements contained in the bid packet, particularly to State of Ohio Prevailing Wage Rates, various insurance requirements, various equal opportunity provisions, and the requirements for a performance bond or a bid guaranty and contract bond for 100% of the contract price.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof. The Council of the City of Oregon, Ohio, reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids.
