Plan holders of the City of Oregon's 2021 Road Improvement Program are hereby notified of the following amendments to the Contract Documents. The following additions, alterations, deletions and/or clarifications shall be part of the Base Bid as much as if they were originally included in the Contract Documents. This Addendum No. 5 is hereby made a part of the Contract Documents.

Quantity adjusted for Reference #6. HDPE or PVC are acceptable for Reference #6. Items for 2" conduit and pull boxes deleted from project.

4) Project #5 Plan Revisions

Delete Page 12/12 from the plan set.

- 1) **Project #2 Bidder Question:** Is the existing pavement buildup available including asphalt/concrete thickness?


Engineer Response: Below are the results from the pavement cores taken from Starr Ext.

11. The bidder shall be prepared to furnish a statement of his financial position and experience record, which will be held confidential by the City.
12. The Contractor shall commence work under his Contract on a date to be specified in a written order from the City and shall fully complete all work thereunder within the time limit stipulated in the Contract.
13. An estimate of the cost of construction completed and of the cost of material delivered or stored during the previous month shall be prepared by the Contractor and approved by the City on or about the first of each month and forwarded to the City for approval and subsequent payment, all in accordance with the requirements of Paragraph 25 of the General Conditions.
14. Secondhand and/or salvaged materials may not be used unless specifically provided for in the detailed specifications or called for on the plans.
15. The Contractor must pay at least the wage rate subsequently listed in the General Conditions.
16. The Contractor shall not assign his Contract or any part thereof without the approval of the City nor without the consent of the surety unless the surety has waived its right to notice of assignment.
17. The Contract will be awarded to the lowest and best bidder. Best bidder will be determined by the Best Bid Criteria as defined by Chapter 180 of the Oregon Municipal Code. The Contract may not be awarded if the price of the Contract is in excess of 10% of the project-estimated cost. The estimated projects cost are as follows:

Bid items may be deleted in their entirety and decreased or increased. The final contract price shall be determined by deleting or adding work at the bid unit prices.

18. The City may award other contracts for additional work and the Contractor shall fully cooperate with such other contractors and carefully fit his own work to that provided under other contracts as may be directed by the City. The Contractor shall not commit nor permit any act, which will interfere with the performance of work by any other contractor or by City employees.
19. Five (5) executed copies of the Contract and Bond will be required.
20. The preliminary estimate previously given is approximate only and the City assumes no responsibility for its accuracy. The Contractor is cautioned to make his own investigations and determinations of the conditions under which the work will be performed and to base his bid accordingly.
21. It is the intention of the City to award one or more contracts for the construction of all of the work described in these specifications.
22. Water for construction will be available to the Contractor. He will be required to acquire a meter from the City (at the regular deposit charge rate), but will not be charged for the water. The Contractor shall also pay for all other utility services provided.
