

NOTICE TO BIDDERS
Ordinance No. 2-2021

Sealed proposals marked for “**OREGON TOWN CENTER – PHASE 1**” will be received by the City of Oregon, Ohio, at the Office of the Director of Public Service at the Oregon Municipal Building, 5330 Seaman Road, Oregon, Ohio 43616-2608, until 10:00 A.M., local time, on Thursday, June 3, 2021, and then opened and read aloud for furnishing the Department of Public Service with the following work:

The proposed work consists of the construction of approximately 3500' of new roadways and a roundabout for a mixed use development between Pickle Road and Dustin Road. The Work includes asphalt pavement, concrete pavement, curb and gutter, storm sewer, waterline, sanitary sewer, drainage, earthwork, pavement markings, signage, lighting, landscaping and miscellaneous work required to complete the project.


Bidding Documents may be examined during normal office hours at the office of the Director of Public Service, 5330 Seaman Road, Oregon, OH 43616. All bids must be made on the proposal forms, which with the contract documents, including Specifications and Bid Forms must be obtained from Newfax Corporation, Inc., 333 West Woodruff Avenue, Toledo, OH 43604, P (419) 241-5157, Mon. through Fri., 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Contact Newfax Corporation for cost of documents. Deposits are non-refundable.

Each bid must be accompanied by either a bid bond in an amount of 10% of the bid amount with a surety satisfactory to the City or by certified check, cashier’s check, or letter of credit upon a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the bid amount in favor of the City of Oregon.

Bid bonds shall be accompanied by Proof of Authority of the official or agent signing the bond. A Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond properly executed can be submitted in lieu of a bid bond or check.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof. The Council of the City of Oregon, Ohio, reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids.
