**RE: Construction Notice**  
Southwest Water Distribution Improvements – Brown Road Trunk Waterline Phase 2

Dear Resident / Property Owner:

This letter is to inform you that the City of Oregon has awarded a construction contract for the Southwest Water Distribution Improvements – Brown Road Trunk Waterline Phase 2 project to replace the local 8-inch waterline with a 16-inch trunk waterline along Brown Road from I-280 to the Toledo Edison Transmission Towers. The project also includes the installation of a 16-inch trunk waterline along the alignment of the Toledo Edison Transmission Towers between Navarre Avenue and Brown Road. Construction work is set to begin mid-February and should be completed by the end of September, 2018.

The project involves the replacement of existing waterline within the existing right-of-way of Brown Road. The waterline replacement will also include new service connections within the right-of-way.

The contractor for the project is Cash Services LLC, 5811 Woodville Road, PO Box 206, Millbury, Ohio, 43447. At the pre-construction meeting for this project, they were told to insure minimal inconvenience and adverse construction conditions during this project. The City of Oregon has hired Quality Control Inspection, Inc. (QCI), 40 Tarbell Avenue, Bedford, Ohio 44146 to provide a full time project representative/inspector on the job. The project representative will be available on site to address any concerns you may have during construction.

The contractor is to notify property owners in advance of any work that may affect access to the property or site utilities. The contractor has submitted a tentative work schedule, however, due to the large scale of the project, weather impacts, and project conditions during construction, the contractor's work schedule may change. Please note, the contractor has indicated that final grading and seeding for the project will not be completed until all testing has been completed.

Due to the nature of the project, we ask that you avoid driving through the construction operation area as much as possible. Additional notices will be provided for any full road closures necessary for this project.
