LUC-Seaman Road Bridge Replacement over Otter Creek (PID 107148)

Dear Resident:

This letter is to inform you that construction to replace the bridge on Seaman Road Bridge over Otter Creek is scheduled to begin the week of June 1, 2020. The City of Oregon has received funding through the Ohio Department of Transportation Municipal Bridge Program for the replacement the existing bridge structure. The project will involve the removal and replacement of the existing bridge structure with a new pre-cast reinforced concrete bridge structure.

The contractor for the Seaman Road Bridge Project is the E.S. Wagner Company, 840 Patchen Rd, Oregon, Ohio 43616. At the pre-construction meeting for this project, they were told to insure minimal inconvenience and adverse construction conditions during this project. Work on the project is expected to be completed by the beginning of September 2020.

The City of Oregon has hired Greenman-Pedersen, Inc. (GPI), 601 West Bagley Road, Berea, Ohio 44017 to provide a full-time project representative/inspector on the job. The project inspector will be onsite at all times during construction to address any concerns encountered during the project.

Construction plans and specifications for the project are available for review at the City of Oregon Municipal Complex at the Department of Public Service Office.
