Dear Property Owner or Current Resident,

This letter is to advise you that the City of Oregon has awarded a contract to The Shelly Company, 1700 Fostoria Avenue, Suite 200, Findlay, OH 45840 to resurface approximately 1.9 miles of Starr Avenue in the City of Oregon from Whittlesey Avenue to Lallendorf Road. The City has received grant funding from the Toledo Metropolitan Area Council of Governments (TMACOG) Transportation Improvement Program through the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) and from the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) for the project.

The project will include resurfacing 1.9 miles of Starr Avenue and making necessary repairs. The project will consist of milling approximately 3” of the existing asphalt surface along the entire project limits, followed by making any necessary base repairs. Following the base repairs, a two course asphalt overlay will be placed over the entire project limits. The project will also include adjustment of manholes, signage, pavement markings, ADA curb ramps and related work, as necessary.

Construction on the project is anticipated to begin the week of Monday, July 6, 2020. The contractor will begin by milling approximately 3” of the existing asphalt surface along the entire project limits, followed by making any necessary base repairs.

At the pre-construction meeting for this project, the contractor was told to ensure minimal inconvenience and adverse construction conditions during this project. The contractor will maintain one lane of traffic throughout the project limits. Access to driveways will be available at all times except when the paving operation is in front of the drive. Emergency access to drives will be available at all times.
